
Aftab Ali Ahmed


Ahmed Kabir Hazarika


Akinali H. Ayemi


Aryaman Choudhary




Aryan Baruah






Astha Saikia Swimming Captain, Girls




Dhajen Basumatary




Divyanshu Agarwal Table Tennis Captain, Boys
