Hongyang Konyak Basketball Captain, Boys



Hriyanka Bhuyan




Indrani Phukan




Ipsita D. Kashyap Cultural Captain, Girls


LEYI LEGO


Nabam Yajo Event Management Prefect




Nishant Borah


