

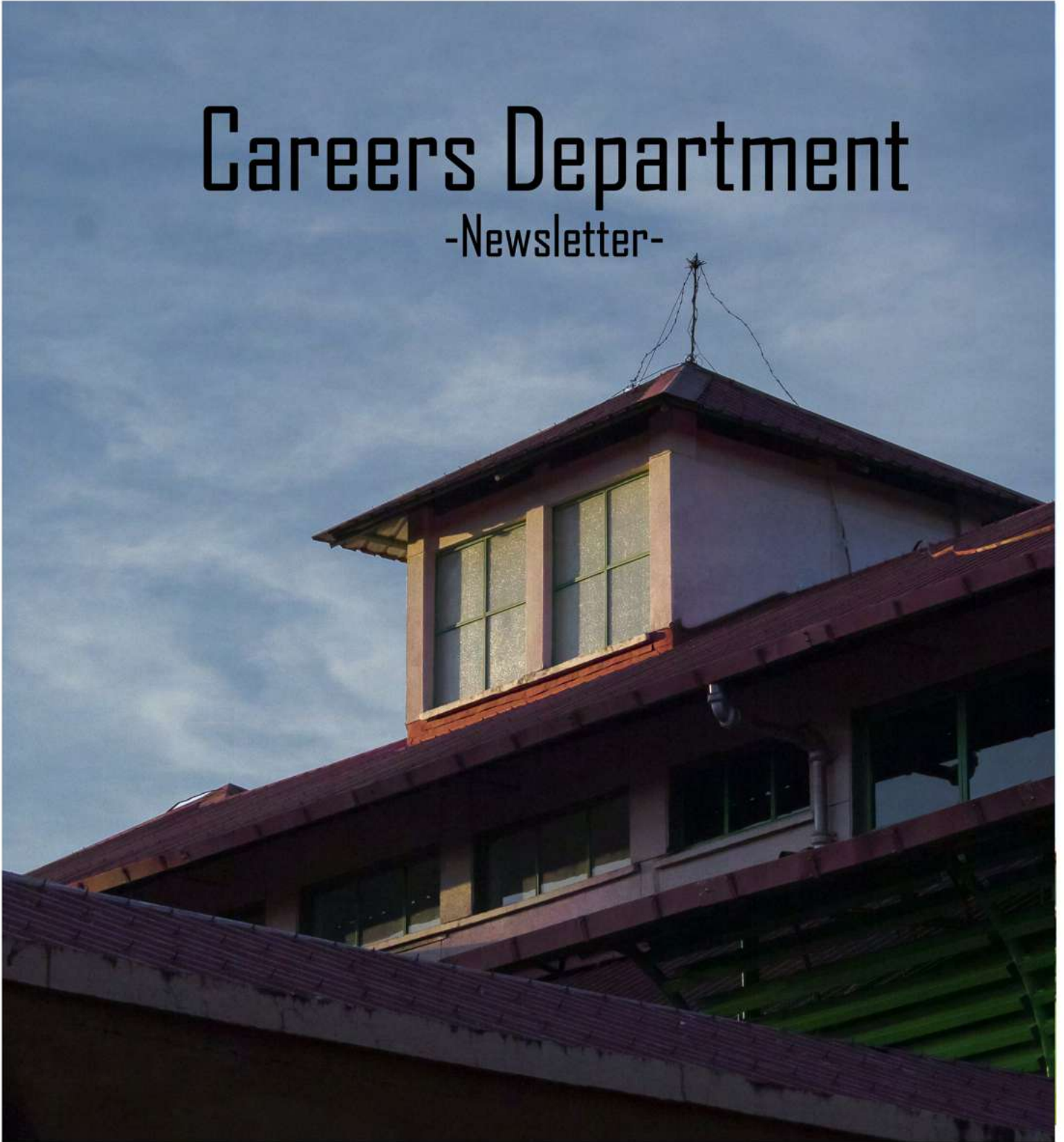

Entrance Exams: National Colleges

Engineering:

1. **JEE Main** - It is a national-level examination scheduled by CBSE to offer admission to eligible applicants in engineering courses at NITs, IIITs, and centrally funded technical institutions such as IIST. JEE Main is also an eligibility test for JEE Advanced. Expected examination dates for entrance exams are the last week of February, the 3rd week of March, the last week of April, and the last week of May 2022.

2. **JEE Advanced** - Only JEE Main qualified applicants will be able to apply for JEE Advanced. This examination is conducted by IITs. The admission to qualifying applicants to all UG engineering & other science courses offered at 16 IITs in India & ISM Dhanbad. There will be 2 papers of 3 hours each. The question paper will be available in Hindi & English both. Each question paper will have 3 separate sections like Physics, Chemistry &

Mathematics. The expected dates for the entrance examinations are the 3rd week of June.

3. **BITSAT** - Birla Institute of Technology & Science Admission Test- This entrance examination is conducted to provide admission to deserving applicants in engineering courses at BITS campuses in Pilani, Goa & Hyderabad. It is an online examination to offer admission at BITS Pilani Engineering, Pharmacy, Information Systems & other courses. The notifications will be published in December & the online examination will be held from May to June.

4. **VITEEE** - Vellore Institute of Technology Engineering Entrance Exam- The eligible applicants will get admission to numerous B Tech degree courses through VITEEE. The application process starts on VITEEE in December & the examination is held in March.

Popular Medical Entrance Exams:

1. **NEET-UG** - National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Exam for Undergraduate- It is a national level entrance examination cum eligibility test to offer admission to eligible applicants in MBBS/BDS courses after the 12th standard Science examination. NEET-UG is scheduled by CBSE.

2. **AFMC** - Armed Forces Medical College Entrance Test is one of the toughest examinations of the country after the 12th standard examination. The duration of this medical course is 4 years & 6 months followed by a 1-year internship. After qualifying for the AFMC entrance examination, the applicants compulsorily have to serve as a commissioned officer in medical services of defense forces minimum of 7 years.

3. **AIIMS MBBS** - It is a national-level medical entrance exam organized by AIIMS after the 12th standard to provide admission to MBBS in AIIMS New Delhi and other 6 new AIIMS like institutions. AIIMS organizes entrance exams for an available number of seats for the MBBS course at AIIMS New Delhi & other 6 institutions.

4. **JIPMER MBBS** - This is a medical entrance exam conducted by JIPMER (Jawaharlal Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research) for the admission of eligible applicants to MBBS courses in the institute. The duration of the course is 4 years & 6 months followed by a 1-year internship.

5. **MUOET**- A University level entrance exam to offer admissions in various UG and PG courses in the field of pharmacy, engineering, and many other programs.

Architecture Entrance Exams:

1. **NATA** - It is an architecture entrance examination to offer admission to interested applicants at the B.Arch program in India in Govt. & Govt. aided & unaided colleges of architecture. This examination can be given at any designated examination center before a minimum of 6 working days of the cut-off date for applying to preferred colleges. The application process for NATA will start in March & the examination can be taken on any

working day from **March to August**. (Note: can be done online).

2. **KCET** - Karnataka Examinations Authority conducts KCET for admissions in the architecture courses. The test is usually conducted in **May** in the first or second week. Based on marks obtained in the KCET (all subjects) as well as NATA equally, the final admissions in the B. Arch. The course will be done.

Law Entrance Exams:

1. **CLAT** - CLAT- It is a Common Law Admission Test scheduled to offer admission at UG & PG courses at 14 National Law Universities. Every year a university out of these 14 will take the responsibility to conduct entrance exams.

(National Law University) conducts AILET (All Indian Law Entrance Test) which is a national level examination.

2. **LSAT** - LSAT- It is Law School Admission Test conducted to provide admissions to Law Courses in participating colleges such as Amity, ITM Gurgaon, RGSOIPL, UPES Dehradun, Faculty of Law Dehradun, for 3 years LLB at IIT Kharagpur & others.

4. **SET** - Symbiosis Entrance Test is conducted by Symbiosis International University which offers admission to L.L.B Courses. Candidates looking for admission to SIU-affiliated colleges can apply for SET.

3. **AILET** - AILET (All Indian Law Entrance Test)- This entrance exam is conducted for admissions at B.A, LLB (Hons.) courses. NLU

5. **BHU Law Entrance Exam**- Banaras Hindu University organizes the BHU Law entrance examination every year for UG and PG law courses. The entrance exam for UG and PG is called the Undergraduate Entrance Test and Postgraduate Entrance Test respectively.

Design Entrance Exams:

1. **NIFT** - NIFT Entrance Test- National Institute of Fashion Technology organizes entrance tests for admissions into its Bachelor's degree programs. For B.Design it conducts GAT & CAT & Situation tests. The applicants have to qualify GAT for admission into B.F Tech.

Test for the admission of eligible applicants to its UG courses at all centers. The application process ends up in **November** every year and the examination is held in **January**.

2. **NID** - NID- It is the National Institute of Design that schedules the Design Aptitude

3. **AIEED** - AIEED (All Indian Entrance Examination for Design)- This examination is conducted for the applicants interested in a 4 years UG course in design after the 12th standard exam.

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
