ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR STUDIES IN NEW ZEALAND

- English requirement - Undergraduate; The applicant must have a score of 6.5 in IELTS.
- 12 Years of Elementary and Secondary education (12/intermediate).
- Most universities in NZ accept a minimum of 75 % aggregate marks and a minimum of 60 % in English.
- Mathematics is required only for science and technology courses.
- Cost of Education for international students
- Estimation: US\$ 10200 tuition fee to support the first year for all students.
- Capital cities and the most expensive universities recommend international students budget US\$ 135000-16900 for the first year.
- Additionally compulsory health insurance is necessary - US\$ 135-470 per year.
- For all the students most universities offer residency - US\$ 180 per week.

Application process

Students can directly apply to universities in New Zealand. They, however, need to read the instructions carefully while enrolling.

- Documents For Admission Process
- Transcripts of class 9,10,11 and Pre-Board/ Tentative Marks in the final of class 12
- Test Scores of entrance exams.
- Letter of Recommendation.
- Resume (if asked)
- Statement of Purpose.
- English language test scores

Canada

Studying in Canada, with its welcoming immigration regulations, is now easier than ever. Furthermore, among international students, it is a popular location for vocational and diploma studies. With over 642,000 international students, Canada is one of the top five study destinations in the world. Undergraduate courses, postgraduate degrees, and short-term courses are all available in Canada. This data illustrates Canada's appeal as an academic destination.

Undergraduate courses in Canada are of three-year duration, while on the other side, an undergraduate diploma's duration can be anywhere between 6 months to 1 year, changing from university to university.

- Requirement of Canadian Universities-
- 70% in 12th grade
- 12th-grade level Math
- TOEFL PBT: 580-600 min (depending upon course)
- TOEFL CBT: 237-250 min (depending upon course)

In addition to the provision of excellent cultural experiences, several of Japan's top colleges are friendly to foreign students. Low crime rates and top-notch healthcare make Japan one of the safest countries to study in the world.

Students choose these courses as Japan has a reputation in terms of innovation and research. Successful international brands like Nissan, Toyota, Panasonic, Canon, and Sony are based in Japan. The country has also made a name for itself in the production of robots for every imaginable need. Unsurprisingly, an excellent higher education system lies behind all this innovation. Many Japanese universities use the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) to determine if an international student has the necessary academic and Japanese language skills to enroll in one of their undergraduate (Bachelor's) programmes.

The EJU evaluates 4 subjects:

- Japanese as a foreign language
- Science (basic Physics, Chemistry, Biology)
- Japan and the world (basic skills in Liberal Arts, critical thinking, and logical abilities)
- Mathematics (basic skills in Math)
- Scores of language proficiency tests for both English and Japanese are required. These include TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, and JLPT. application deadline for the spring intake: October/November

- for the summer intake: February/April
- for the autumn intake: June/July
