Have undertaken the IB, GCE A Levels, or CBSE/ISC in India

- AUD 10,000 one-off payment (fee reduction applied to the first year of tuition)
- AUD 20,000 one-off payment (fee reduction applied to the first year of tuition)
- **50% fee remission scholarship**, valid for the duration of the undergraduate degree
- **100% fee remission scholarship**, valid for the duration of the undergraduate degree

OBTAINING A VISA: Most international students require a student visa to study in Australia. There are several different types of student visas based on the type, of course, you will be studying.

Based in the heart of London, North-eastern University London has developed a reputation for delivering an excellent university experience and has exceeded all Russell Group universities for overall student satisfaction in the UK's National Student Survey for four consecutive years.

Application -

- You may submit either the <u>Common</u> <u>Application</u> or <u>Coalition Application</u>
- Your application must be submitted by the <u>deadline</u>, along with either the application fee (\$75) or a fee waiver request.

Eligibility/Requirements -

- Your O cial High School Transcript must be submitted to the university by your counsellor or another school o cial. Transcripts should include any final grades from freshman, sophomore, and junior year; first trimester or first semester grades should be sent when they become available.
- Your high school should submit the Mid-Year Report if you were deferred to Regular Decision.
- You will need to provide an o cial translation for any transcripts which are not provided in English.

- If you are applying from a high school with non-traditional grading policies or narrative evaluations instead of traditional grades, you are required to submit your narrative reports for your application to be complete.
- If you have been out of high school for more than one year, you are still required to submit your most recent transcript.
- If you earned your GED, you must submit an o cial GED score report, along with your high school transcript through the final year you completed.

Advanced Credits

- Freshmen are eligible to receive credit from Advanced Placement (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations, or certain international maturity certificate examinations.
- If you received credit for any courses completed at a college or university, you must request for an o cial college or university transcript to be sent directly to northeastern.

Counsellor Recommendation and Teacher Evaluation-

They require one teacher recommendation and one school counsellor recommendation. Please ask your recommender to send their letter as a PDF to -

admissions@northeastern.edu.

English Proficiency -

All students, regardless of citizenship, must demonstrate English language proficiency when applying to northeastern. You can satisfy the requirement in the following ways:

- You are a native English speaker.
- You will complete 4 consecutive academic years before enrolling at Northeastern in a high school or university where native English was the primary instructional language -AND- you submit an English Proficiency Waiver Request through your Application Status Check.
- You submit, along with your application, o cial test results directly from the testing agency for one of the following English language proficiency tests:
- C1 Advanced or C2 Proficiency (Cambridge English)
- Duolingo English Test (DET)
- IELTS Academic
- PTE Academic

• TOEFL Internet-based Test (CEEB Code: 3667) North-eastern will accept either the in-person version completed in a test centre, or the TOEFL iBT Home Edition

Plaksha's journey started in 2015, as a conversation among a few friends about how and why technology education needs to change. This group of people, most of them entrepreneurs and business leaders, were keen to change the landscape of engineering and technology education in India and the world.

Reimagining Higher Education Foundation, a Section 8 not-for-profit company, was set up in 2017 with the mission of converting the idea into a plan. In Feb 2019, the groundbreaking of Plaksha University's campus in Mohali took place intending to open the campus in Aug 2021.

Application Form Requirements

- Standardised Test Scores
- Academic scores: Grades 9, 10, 11, and 12 marks (where available)
- Written or video essays
- Extracurricular activities, achievements, and creative projects
- Leadership roles
- Sports-related achievements

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants should be currently enrolled in Grade 12 or equivalent or should have completed Grade 12 (or equivalent)
- Should have studied mathematics till Grade 12 for all undergraduate programs
- Should have studied physics till Grade 12 to apply to B. Tech in Computer Science and AI, Robotics and Cyber-Physical Systems, and Biological Systems Engineering
- We strongly encourage you to submit at least one of these scores SAT, ACT, JEE Mains, Grade 12, or equivalent board scores to be eligible for a firm offer of admission.
- Students who apply using only predicted scores are eligible for a conditional offer of admission.
- Admission decisions are of 4 types Firm offer, conditional offer, deferral of decision, and denial. To know more click on the 'Admission Policies' button on the left

CHRIST UNIVERSITY

CHRIST (Deemed to be University) was established as 'Christ College' in 1969. It undertook path-breaking initiatives in Indian higher education with the introduction of innovative and modern curricula, insistence on academic discipline, imparting of Holistic Education, and adoption of global higher education practices with the support of creative and dedicated staff.



The University Grants Commission (UGC) of India conferred Autonomy to Christ College in 2004 and identified it as an Institution with Potential for Excellence in 2006. In 2008 under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Ministry of Human Resource Development of the Government of India, declared the institution Deemed to be University, in the name and style of Christ University. One of the first institutions in India to be accredited in 1998 by the NAAC, and subsequently in 2004 and 2016, CHRIST (Deemed to be University) has the top grade 'A' on the 4-point scale.
