PRINCETON UNIVERSITY (EST. 1746), PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY



Princeton University is one of the oldest Ivy League Universities in the USA. It is well known worldwide for its academic resources like libraries, state-of-the-art laboratories, and an on-campus art museum. Although Princeton offers courses in many areas, it does not have schools of medicine, law, education, and business.

PROCESS OF APPLICATION

To apply, you will need to submit the Common Application and the Princeton Supplement. You can apply to Princeton as a first-year student through single-choice early action or regular decision. Transfer applicants must apply through the transfer process. Before you begin preparing your application, we encourage you to review our standardized testing policy and review our helpful tips. For those applying through the Quest Bridge application, please visit our Quest Bridge National College Match page for more information.

Submit

- A Completed Application. You must submit your application online through the <u>Common Application</u>. Princeton's CEEB Code: 2672
- Princeton's Supplement. In addition to the application provided by the Common Application, all applicants must submit the <u>Princeton Supplement</u>. You must compulsorily submit the Princeton Supplement online through the Common Application website.
- Application Fee or Fee Waiver. You may submit a fee waiver one of two ways: 1) Select the fee waiver option on the Common Application. Your school counselor must approve your fee waiver request online or submit your fee waiver form by mail or fax. 2) Select one of the following fee waiver options on the Princeton Supplement: Princeton-specific, ACT, College Board, or NACAC. All low-income students are eligible for the Princeton-specific fee waiver. Additionally, all applicants serving or having served in the U.S. military are eligible for the Princeton-specific fee waiver. If you use the Princeton-specific fee waiver, you do not need to get approval from your college counselor or academic adviser.
- Graded Written Paper. A graded written
 paper is required, preferably in the subjects of
 English or history.

Request

- Transcript. An official transcript must be sent by a school counselor or school official.
- School Report (SR). The SR form is available on the Common Application website.
- Kindly ask your school counselor or other school officials to complete and submit the
- SR form.
- Counselor Recommendation. If you use the Common Application online, please note that the SR and the Counselor Recommendation are separate items. Be sure to "invite" your school counselor or academic adviser to complete both items.
- Two (2) Teacher Recommendations. Kindly ask two of your teachers who have taught you in higher-level courses (e.g., AP, IB Higher / Standard Level, A-Levels, etc.) in different academic areas of study to complete and send the teacher recommendation forms, available on the Common Application website. The subjects should be in core academic areas, such as English, language, humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, or math.
- Midyear School Report. Please ask your school counselor or other school officials to complete and submit this form when your midyear grades are available.

DARTMOUTH COLLEGE (EST: 1769), HANOVER, NEW HAMPSHIRE



Like the other Ivy League colleges, Dartmouth college is also a private institution. The college is known for its inter-college athletics and Native American presence. It offers majors in the arts, humanities, social sciences, and engineering. APPLICATION REQUIREMENT FOR DARTMOUTH UNIVERSITY:

To have the best shot of getting in, you should aim for the 75th percentile, with a 1550 SAT or a 35 ACT. You should also have a 4.11 GPA or higher. If your GPA is lower than this, you need to compensate with a higher SAT/ACT score.

For a school as selective as Dartmouth, you'll also need to impress them with the rest of your application.

But if you apply with a score below a 1550 SAT or a 35 ACT, you, unfortunately, start with the odds against you and have a tiny chance of getting in. There are just too many students with high SAT/ACT scores and strong applications, and you need to compete against them.

If you plan to apply to one of our test-optional colleges/schools, you are welcome to submit unofficial test scores to Cornell University. Should you be admitted and enrolled at Cornell, we will require official test scores sent from the testing agency at that time.

For All Applicants to Current and Future Terms: Please do not feel you need to take exams unless you can take the exam locally near your home and you feel safe in doing so.

As a reminder, we will evaluate your application without standardized testing. For your health and safety, please always adhere to your local, state, and national COVID-19 guidelines.

Submit Your Application

- Early Decision application deadline November 1 (11:59 p.m. applicant's local time).
- Regular Decision application deadline January 3 (11:59 p.m. applicant's local time).
- Complete your application via the Common Application.
- Brown's supplemental essays are submitted through the Common Application.
- Submit the \$75 application fee or a fee waiver.
- If you are applying to the eight-year <u>Program in Liberal Medical Education (PLME)</u> or the five-year <u>Brown|Rhode Island School of Design Dual Degree Program (BRDD)</u> you must complete the special program essays.

Request School Forms

- Transcript. An official copy of your high school transcript must be sent by your school counselor or school official.
- School Report. The <u>School Report</u> form is available through the Common Application website and must be completed and submitted by your school counselor or school official.
- Midyear School Report and

Transcript. Due February 24 or as soon as possible upon the completion of your first semester or second trimester of your final year of high school, the Midyear Report and Transcript can be submitted online through the Common Application by your guidance counselor or another school official. The Midyear Report includes information such as your GPA and class rank (if your school provides this

- information) and shares with us whether there have been any course changes or other updates since you submitted your application. It is accompanied by a Midyear Transcript that includes your most recent available grades. If you are not given midyear grades or evaluations (e.g., home-schooled students, some non-U.S. schools), please include a note explaining your circumstances under the "Additional Information" heading on the writing section of the Common Application.
- Counselor Recommendation. Please note that the School Report and Counselor Recommendation are separate items on the Common Application. Be sure to "invite" your school counselor to complete both items.

- Two Teacher Evaluations/Recommendations. Two letters of recommendation from teachers who have taught you in major academic subjects (science, social studies, mathematics, a foreign language, or English) must be submitted through the Common Application or sent via <a href="mailto:emai
- Bachelor of Science and PLME Recommendations. If you are considering a concentration in a STEM field, or the Program in Liberal Medical Education (PLME), at least one of your recommendations should come from a math or a science teacher.
- Final School Report and Transcript. Due by June 22 for students who have chosen to matriculate at Brown, the <u>Final School Report</u> and Transcript must be submitted online through the Common Application by your school counselor or another school official. The Final School Report confirms your graduation date and alerts us of any course changes or other updates. The Final Transcript will include your final grades and confirm the successful completion of your secondary education.
- First Quarter/Trimester Grades. Early Decision applicants are required to have their counselor submit first-quarter or trimester grades as soon as they are available. All applicants should have their school submit midyear or second-trimester grades as soon as they are available.
- Early Decision Agreement. Early Decision applicants are required to complete the <u>Early Decision Agreement</u> form through the Common Application. This form requires the signature of the applicant, parent/guardian, and school counselor. Submitting this agreement confirms your commitment to enroll at Brown if admitted Early Decision.

COMMON UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE TEST (CUET)

The Common University Entrance Test (CUET (UG) - 2023) is being introduced for admission into all UG Programmes in all Central Universities for the academic session 2023-24 under the Ministry of Education, (MoE). The Common University Entrance Test (CUET) will provide a common platform and equal opportunities to candidates across the country, especially those from rural and other remote areas, and help establish better connections with the Universities. A single examination will enable the Candidates to cover a wide outreach and be part of the admissions process to various Central Universities.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has recently announced the CUET PG Registration 2023 through an official announcement. According to the official notification, the admissions for the postgraduate courses in various central and participating universities of session 2023-24 have been announced. The Chairman of the University Grants Commission (UGC), Prof. Mamidala Jagadesh Kumar, said- "Next week, NTA will announce CUET PG 2023 test dates and application dates. CUET-PG is expected to be held in the first/second week of June 2023."

Participating Universities in CUET in 2023 - Key Points

- Before filling out the application form, applicants should review the list of CUET 2023 participating universities.
- While filling out the application form, candidates must choose three CUET participating universities.
- Before applying, candidates should review the CUET eligibility requirements. The CUET member universities' qualifying standards for a program vary based on the institutes.
- It is critical to choose the right CUET participating universities while completing the application form since changes will not be permitted afterward.
- Candidates who wish to enroll in more than three CUET participating universities in 2023 must pay an additional fee of Rs. 800 (in the General/OBC category) and Rs. 350 (in the SC/ST category).
- Candidates must use extreme caution while choosing a CUET-participating university's program code.
- Before filling out the CUET 2023 application form, candidates must have their papers available.
- Candidates must report to the CUET participating universities to claim their admissions when the merit lists are announced.
