

CAREER OPTIONS IN THE ARMED FORCES



As we previously indicated in our Careers Newsletter, students in grades 11 and 12 are perplexed and having trouble selecting the best career path following graduation from high school. So, here we are with yet another career option for our students. All student streams have access to these dream employment alternatives. After completing their education, anyone who wants to join the Indian Army should be well-informed about the recruitment process. in order for the students to appropriately prepare for the same. This post that we have created could answer all of your questions about how to find a good career in the Ministry of Defence.

There are the following ways to join the Indian Armed Forces-





1. NATIONAL DEFENCE ACADEMY (NDA)



The initial crest consisted of a sword, a quill pen, an anchor, and an eagle, symbolizing the four fields in which the Cadets received education at the National War Academy. The present Academy insignia was selected in 1948. The background is maroon, which is an apt colour of heraldry but also a symbol of chivalry and sacrifice. The crest is composed of the symbols of the three Services superimposed on each other and mounted on top of the Ashoka Capitol. The anchor supports the sword and both support the eagle. In this combined form they are no longer four separate entities but fused into one whole representing the joint Manship of the Armed Forces of India.

Academy Motto- The scroll or motto is fashioned on a ribbon at the base of the insignia upon which the sword hilts and the bottom of the anchor stand. The motto has been inspired and extracted from the Bhagavad Gita:

(Karmanevadhikaraste ma phaleshu kadachina)

(Your duty is action with no eye on the fruits it will bring)

The ideal ('nishkam karma') was put in the scroll in its English translation as 'Service Before Self'. In the fifties it was decided to do away with an English motto and have a corresponding Sanskrit version, keeping in line with Indian culture. Thus, 'Service Before Self' was translated into 'Seva Parmo Dharm'.

The National Defence Academy (NDA) exam is conducted by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) twice a year. The selection of the candidates is done on the basis of written tests, SSB interviews, and medical tests. On the basis of the candidate's performance in the above stages, the selected candidates are sent to 3 years of training.

2. ENTRY SCHEMES - GRADUATION UPSC



(a) Indian Military Academy Direct (IMA) - The Indian Military Academy (IMA) is one of the

oldest military academies in India, and trains officers for the Indian Army. Located in Dehradun, Uttarakhand, it was established in 1932 following a recommendation by a military committee set up under the chairmanship of General (later Field Marshal) Sir Philip Chetwode. From a class of 40 male cadets in 1932, IMA now has a sanctioned capacity of 1,650. Cadets undergo a training course varying between 3 and 16 months depending on entry criteria. On completion



of the course at IMA cadets are permanently commissioned into the army as Lieutenants.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

The IMA cadets are required to undergo training at the academy for one year. While the graduates of a non-military college have to carry forward the training for one and a half years. The candidates who make it up to IMA are selected through various competitive exams.

There are various levels for which candidates have to prepare themselves for joining IMA. Some of the basic pre-requisite requirements for selection are Age limit, Physical and Medical requirements, etc,

If you are an Army aspirant, you need to check out the selection procedure of the Indian Military Academy Examination (IMA exam) attested below:

- 1. Written Examination
- 2. Medical Test
- 3. Interview

The IMA aspirants must have a degree in any discipline from a recognised university. Similar to any other force, you need to pass the entrance exam to join IMA.
