Manas House was eventually wiped out and the game ended with Lohit House on 69/5; the match was terminated with Manas at 42/5 since it was getting dark. Since then cricket at The Assam Valley School has become one of the major sports on campus. Mr. Ifikhar Hasan, former Master-In-Charge, Cricket (Ranji Player, Rajasthan), took keen interest to develop this game among the boys and girls. From the junior in class 5 to the senior in class 12, one can observe them training every day. In the year 2018, BCCI started conducting board matches at the AVS cricket ground where we witnessed the Vijay Merchant Trophy and the Cooch Behar Trophy matches. The COVID 19 pandemic in recent years had an impact on the players because it prevented them from competing in tournaments and hampered their development, but it didn't stop them from playing and enjoying the game. Our U-17 team was given an opportunity to compete in the IPSC event in the year 2022. This year too our U-17 team participated in the IPSC U-17 tournament held in the first week of October 2023 where they played till the Quarter-Final by defeating DPS, R.K. Puram, Emerald Heights School, Indore and B.K. Birla School, Pune.
